Upcoming Sampling Events

- **MAY OR JUNE:**
Habitat Assessment and Biomonitoring
Walk your stream site and see what lives in it. Assessments may occur over more than one day.
- **MAY 15, 16 or 17: Herbicide and E. coli Sampling**
Collect water samples for triazine herbicides and E. coli lab analyses
- **JULY 24, 25 or 26: E. coli Sampling**
Collect water samples for E. coli lab analysis
- **SEPTEMBER 18, 19, or 20: Nutrient and E. coli Sampling** Collect water samples for bacteria and chemical lab analyses.
