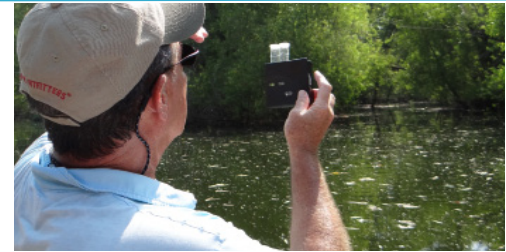
## Sampling Schedule:
